What to do when a Stray Finds You.....

Notes to remember:

- * If you feed them - they will stay and eventually depend on you! The SDHS, Norfolk County and other branches of the SPCA will consider them yours!



- * If they are healthy and happy, they will fend for themselves
- * If they are intact males, they will mark their territories (even though you may own your home, they will make sure you own their scent) Yes, some females will do the same!
- * If you have concerns about the stray's well-being, perhaps it seems pregnant, or maybe looks malnourished, or it has a damaged limb or other obvious injury or illness ... call the SDHS immediately to follow through with assessment
- * If the animal is unapproachable or showing sign of non-social behaviour, leave them alone.

Feline Leukemia and FIV are highly transmittable diseases within the cat population. Testing at your vets before allowing stray contact with your pets is highly advisable.

- ♻️ We do not get tax dollars from any level of government or other organizations (ex: United Way)

- ♻️ The only paid position in the Society is the Agent, who investigates Cruelty and Neglect cases. All others who "work" for the Society are volunteers!
- ♻️ Food, supplies, vet care, advertising etc. for each animal is covered by the SDHS while the animal is in care

Spayed/Neutered and vaccinated to date
